- Finding school work or break times hard
- Not getting on with friends or teachers
- Feeling upset or angry about school
- Getting into trouble at school

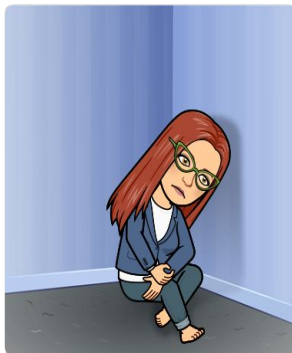
Some things about me:

I write a report for your parents and teachers which tells them all about your strengths and with lots of ideas about what they can do next to help you. Your parents will show you the report if you want to read it.
